

Photography Post for Cycle race

This role has been created to provide photographic support to the largest amateur road, stage race in the United Kingdom. The 'Ras De Cymru' Cycle race, takes place from June 27th – July 1st 2012, and participants will have the opportunity to purchase photos of their experience immediately post-event. It would suit highly organised, creative photography students with an interest in gaining experience in sports photography and further developing their portfolio.

Role

- To provide creative sports photography to support to the Race.
- To capture exciting action and still images of the event in locations across South East Wales, which could include the University's Caerleon Campus, Usk, Abergavenny and Brecon.
- To arrange the taking of photos through static and mobile means, in discussion with the event organisers.
- To increase the likelihood of image purchase through use of quick reflexes, an eye for detail and technical proficiency.
- To assist in the process of ordering, production and making provision of photographs to cyclists.

Responsibilities:

- To develop more intricate event knowledge in order to build an understanding of the event times, locations and an understanding of the riders' experience and increase the likelihood of images that encapsulate these.
- To ensure your own personal safety and the safety of others in conducting the role.
- Photography students would be expected to utilise their own equipment.
- Must be able to work to strict production deadlines, under the direction of the event organisers

Incentives

To be part of the UK's largest and exciting amateur road race. There is potential that high profile riders will take part, including the GB Olympic ladies team. As well as providing invaluable experience and Portfolio building, a profit share arrangement will be available upon the purchase of photographs. In addition, public liability insurance will be in place for all existing students taking up the role.
