

Event Marshal Role

This role is essential to the safe and smooth running of University events such as the Duathlon. It would suit enthusiastic individuals with an interest in developing event experience and working as part of a team.

Role:

- Cover fixed marshalling points to guide and direct participants around the course, dealing with any issues that may occur in a cool and calm manner.
- To ensure signage is appropriately placed for competitors and removed following the event.
- To be fully conversant with emergency procedures and event details.
- Be alert and ready to act appropriately during emergency situations.
- To be the 'eyes and ears' on the route acting as a communication link between the race, race officials and competitors.
- To be helpful, friendly and encouraging to competitors and the public.

Responsibilities:

- Attend a pre- race briefing where you will be informed of your exact duties.
- To communicate effectively with the race organiser, other marshals, competitors and public.
- Wear the marshals jacket to make yourself known to the competitors.

Incentives: Invaluable experience of events relating to the sport's National Governing Body, CV building, all marshals will also receive an event goodie bag.
