## GUIDELINES FOR SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANTS

- Applicants must hold an offer for a Taught Postgraduate programme at the University of Wales, Newport.
- Applicants must have firmly accepted the offer made by the University of Wales, Newport before submitting an application.
- Conditional offer holders may apply for the scholarship but an award can only be made if conditions are met.
- The deadline for applications is :  
Applicants starting in September 2010: 30<sup>th</sup> August 2010  
Applicants starting in January 2011: 3<sup>rd</sup> January 2011
- The scholarship application must be typed (or reasons for not doing so given) and must be a piece of original work signed by the applicant.
- All scholarship applicants must agree to provide a student profile to be used in publications for the purposes of marketing the University of Wales, Newport.
- Current University of Wales, Newport students are not eligible to apply.
- Applicants who defer entry must apply for the academic year in which their studies will start.
- Scholarships are valued at £1,000 each and will be deducted from the total tuition fee.
- Scholarship awards are made by the Scholarship Committee and all decisions are final.
- Students will be notified in September if they have been successful and there will be a ceremony held early in the academic year to celebrate the awards.
